

## CAP General Meeting, December 5th, 2020

The CAP General Meeting on December 5th was conducted solely for the purpose of approving the 2021 proposed budget and electing CAP Officers necessary for the conduct of business in 2021. Elections were held for a CAP President, Vice President, and three Governors. The election took place outdoors at the Beach pavilion due to COVID restrictions.

We had no candidates for President, but offered a write in on the ballot. Our candidate for Vice-President was Janice Roderick. Janice has served on the Board for over 20 year. She is our Acting Vice President and Social Committee Chair. Our candidates for Governors included Paul O'Hearn and Virginia White who were seeking re-election, and Holly Estrada who is a new volunteer. Paul has served on the Board for 3 years and is CAP Maintenance Committee Chair. Virginia White has served on the Board for 3 years, and is our current Treasurer. Our new volunteer, Holly Estrada, has been a CAP member for 16 years and looks forward to the opportunity to take a more active role in the community.

According to CAP ByLaws, at least 20% of our members had to vote in order to meet a quorum. We made quorum with 30 votes, and all measures passed unanimously. Our CAP 2021 Budget was approved and new CAP Officers were elected. Congratulations to Janice Roderick our Vice President (1-year term), Paul O'Hearn our #7 Governor (3-year term), Virginia White our #8 Governor (3-year term), and new to CAP Holly Estrada, our #9 Governor (3-year term). There were no candidates for President and, therefore, are still in need of one for calendar year 2021.
